Hi Garth,

As promised here is some information regarding a possible hosting of cinp.ca at TRIUMF:

- Physical Sciences Division has granted approval for TRIUMF to host the CINP website (J. Dilling, Associate Lab Director & C. Ruiz, Nuc. Phys. Dept. Head). This was also run by the Deputy Director (R. Krücken).
- Head of Core Computing & Networking (CCN), K. Raywood, was consulted, and sees no issues.
- There already exists a server with a Virtual Machine (VM) set up for the TRIUMF Astrophysics Group Website (astro.triumf.ca) using Drupal, that could also host cinp.ca.
- astro.triumf.ca was designed by a local Vancouver web/IT company, called LeftRightMinds, who are due to make an upgrade of astro.triumf.ca to Drupal 2, and are very familiar with the VM system and have special permissions/access to the VM granted by TRIUMF CCN. They have offered to provide a quote for (a) migrating cinp.ca to the TRIUMF server into a fully operational form and (b) performing regular system updates on some basis (e.g. monthly or bi-annually).
- TRIUMF Chief Information Officer, Davis Swan, has agreed to assist with DNS details - we need to know:
  - who owns the domain
  - who manages the server that is doing the redirect to U.Regina
  - Once he has that info, we could transfer ownership of domain cinp.ca to TRIUMF and have on the list of domains that TRIUMF renews annually.
- I understood that CINP has a budget of perhaps around \$1,000 for doing the transfer. I let LeftRightMinds know that there are budgetary constraints, but from what I understand it's not a big job for them. It might be discussed at meeting how much could be in the budget for the regular administration of updates? The idea is that TRIUMF don't perform these, they only perform the linux server updates. Any Drupal updates are done by the company.
- I assumed that we'd want to move on this by end of Calendar year, so have let everyone involved know that.
- I haven't received quote yet, but if I get it before meeting will forward to you.

I hope this is useful.
